



Medication-assisted treatment (MAT) refers to the use of certain **FDA-approved medications** to relieve drug and alcohol cravings and is an increasingly common rehab option for patients with alcohol and/or opiate use disorders.

MAT for Opiate Use Disorder

- Naltrexone
 - Blocking Medication
 - Binds and blocks opioid receptors
- Methadone
 - Replacement Medication
 - Suppresses and reduces craving for abused drugs
- Buprenorphine
 - Anti-Craving / Replacement Medication
 - Suppresses and reduces craving for abused drugs
